Notable Moments in Our Season

Attendees of the June 2024 Annual Luncheon, held at Como Lakeside Pavilion, enjoyed live music by guitarist, Miloš Soćanin and baritone / piano collaboration between Zhicheng He and Hannah Mae Swanson. Attendees also enjoyed a speech by Featured Guest Dr. Patrick R. Warfield, Professor and Director of the University of Minnesota School of Music. This year's *An die Musik* awardee was to Libby Larsen, not only in recognition of her creative, thought-provoking energy as a Schubert Club Board member, but also because she is a leading musical vioce in our country.

Parivaar

Minnesota-based South Asian American composer Shruthi Rajasekar curated a program for Schubert Club Mix, which included a set by Maithree, food, a musical flash mob at intermission and the premiere of a new work, Parivaar (the Sanskrit word for *family*). Between filmed sequences and live performers on stage, over 100 South Asian performing artists of all ages were involved.

Golda Schultz & Jonathan Ware Recital

South African soprano Golda Schultz performed a debut recital at the Ordway with collaborative pianist Jonathan Ware. Their program included a new set of songs, *This Be Her Verse* by Kathleen Tagg. We are thankful to the artists and the composer for giving us permission to record the songs and share them on our website over the summer.

Student Connections

Last season, we launched a new club just for students, Connections. There were some memorable meetings and masterclasses with Orion Weiss and guitarist Miloś. A student guitar ensemble performed in the Ordway lobby before an International Artist Series recital, and Connections members enjoyed two pre-concert social events and post-concert backstage visits.

Programs featured chamber music favorites performed throughout four concerts. Pianist and composer Stephen Prutsman returned for the popular annual Accordo with Silent Movies.











Bruce P. Carlson Student Scholarship Competition

The 101st Scholarship Competition took place in March at Macalester College. 180 students participated with video submissions. 75 were advanced to finals that were judged by Deborah Voigt, Lawrence Dutton, Anne-Marie McDermott, Russell Peterson and Nicholas Goluses. Following each final round, the judges spent a half hour with all finalists. This proved to be a rewarding experience for both students and judges. Prize winners performed at the *Musicians on the Rise* recital in the Ordway Concert Hall.

Musical Promise Scholarships

We added a fourth student to this program, which provides resources and mentorship to young musicians with promise and commitment. The newest scholarship recipient is a young pianist nominated by Hopewell Music Cooperative. In addition to her lessons, the scholarship allowed her to attend a piano camp at MacPhail over the summer. Other community partnerships to date are Walker | West Music Academy, MacPhail Center for Music and the GTCYS Harmony program.













Music Educational Programming


Project CHEER continues to provide after school instrument lessons to about 100 young students. The program began at the Hallie Q. Brown Community Center in 1969 and continues there today. Recently, Project CHEER expanded to the Mount Airy Boys and Girls Club in East St Paul.

This past year, we made some significant changes to the education program schedule. Teaching artists and ensembles were in residence for intense weeks of activity which included *KidsJam, FamilyJam*, schools visits and often a video recording for the Museum Minis online series. *FamilyJam* is bringing dozens of families to the Schubert Club Music Museum on Saturday mornings for mini-concerts and participatory activities.

Participation in the *Let's Make Music* program has skyrocketed; every session offered was filled.









Schubert Club Music Museum

We have embraced a clear vision of the Schubert Club Music Museum as an educational tool first and foremost. It supports our mission and commitment to music education by offering inspiring musical experiences and exposure to the musical instruments from many different world cultures. Museum visitor numbers last year exceeded 10,000 for the first time ever.



Work is well underway on a multi-media exhibit to celebrate the **Gilman Ordway Manuscript Collection**. A book featuring ten new letters donated to the Schubert Club recently by Margaret Ordway is also close to completion. We are working to complete a full set of transcriptions of all letters in the collection. This past year we have been grateful for significant help from the Italian Cultural Center and the Germanic-American Institute.

The **Historical Keyboard Instrument Collection** continues to be a highlight for many Schubert Club Music Museum visitors. Thanks to a recent bequest from longtime Board member James Callahan, work will soon begin on the cleaning and restoration of one of our 19th century Viennese pianos.


